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1. Introduction

Sharples Environmental Services cc (SES) has been appointed by Bitou Local Municipality, to undertake the Environmental Impact Assessment for the Proposed Green Valley Mixed-Use Development on Portion 28 & 32 of the Farm Wittedrift No. 306, & Associated Bulk Infrastructure, in Plettenberg Bay.




Figure 1: Locality of proposed development.

LOCATION DESCRIPTION

The site for the proposed mixed use development is located on portion 28 and 32 of the Farm Wittedrift No. 306. It is an easterly extension of the existing Greenvalley informal settlement located on the outskirts of Wittedrift. The proposed development will be undertaken in Ward 1 of the Bitou Local Municipality, within the town of Plettenberg Bay in the Western Cape.




Figure 2: Proposed Bulk Water and Sewer Routes

The preliminary bulk services routes would cross the following properties, as shown in Figure 2:

- Remainder of Portion 1 of Farm 444
- Portion 133 of Farm 444

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTIVITY




Figure 3: Proposed Draft Layout

The Bitou Municipality proposes to construct a mixed-use development, consisting mostly of lowand middle-income housing opportunities (359 single residential units and 33 high density blocks), & associated infrastructure (water and sewage pipeline infrastructure). In addition, business erven, community use areas, a Primary school, an early childhood development centre, places of worship, a sports field and Public Open Spaces are proposed, as per the draft layout in Figure 3.




Figure 4: Proposed distribution of on-site notices, letter-drops and emails to adjacent properties.




Figure 5: Close-up of Proposed Letter Drops
