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REHABILITATION OF THE ROAD TR75/1 NEAR OUDTSHOORN

<u>Proposed rehabilitation of the road TR75/1 (Trunk Road/N12-Highway) near Oudtshoorn,</u> <u>Oudtshoorn Local Municipality, Garden Route District Municipality, Western Cape.</u>

Landowner consent Requirements

The proposed project will see to the rehabilitation of a portion of the TR75/1 (Trunk Road / N12-Highway). The works will start in Oudtshoorn and continue south for approximately 14.9 km. The project therefore lies within the ambient of a linear activity, where linear activities are defined in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2014, as amended (Government Notice Regulation (GNR) 326 of 2017) as:

"an activity that is arranged in or extending along one or more properties and which affects the environment or any aspect of the environment along the course of the activity, and includes railways, roads, canals channels, funiculars, pipelines, conveyor belts, cableways, power lines, fences, runways, aircraft landing strips, firebreaks and telecommunication lines."

As per Subregulation 39(2) of the EIA Regulations of 2014, as amended (GNR 326 of 2017), written consent of the landowner is not required in respect of linear activities (Subregulation 39(2)(a)).

The Applicant has however provided additional confirmation that the road's reserve was officially proclaimed in 1971. In terms of Section 22 of the Road Ordinance, 1976, the ownership of all proclaimed public roads as well as the land comprised within its boundaries vest with the relevant road authority. The Western Cape Government's Department of Infrastructure has is therefore the rightful owner of the reserve in question (confirmation has been attached as Annexure 1 of this letter).

The table below provides a list of the various affected properties. It is the duty of the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to, as part of the EIA process, to give written notice to the occupiers of the site, owners of the site, persons in the land adjacent to the site and persons in control of the site where the activity is or is to be undertaken. The landowners and occupants (where different from the landowners) will be notified of the proposed works during the Public Participation Process for the proposed project.
